IMPORTANT TO EXHIBITORS

1. Proof of liability insurance must accompany each entry form for the animals being shown. Entries will not be processed until this is received and are subject to late entry fees.
2. Entries close on Friday, **September 9th, 2016** at 4:00 p.m. Entries will not be taken over the phone.
3. The entry fee is 15% of the prize money awarded.
4. Late entry fee is an additional 5% of the prize money awarded.
5. All exhibits must be weighed at the fair prior to showing. The birth weight, show weight and weight per day of age for all calves and yearlings to be exhibited in individual classes are to be posted.
6. Cattle must not be removed before 4:00 p.m. the day of the show.

STALLS CANNOT BE RESERVED - FIRST COME - FIRST SERVED

Any Exhibitors using stalls overnight must have approval by director in charge

ATTENTION

Each breed must be shown separately and have at least:

1. Three exhibitors per breed
2. Twenty-four (24) animals per breed exhibited at class "A" fairs, of which Carp is one. If these qualifications are not met by the individual breeds, only half of the prize money will be paid.
3. All purebred registered animals, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually or jointly) are considered to be the production of the farm or breeding unit on which they are maintained.
4. Each breeding unit is allowed a maximum of 10 exhibits excluding the Breeder's Herd and Get-of- Sire classes. All exhibits must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor. Note the exception of the Get-of-Sire and Breeder's Herd classes.
5. All animals being shown in single classes must be registered at the time of entries closing, except calves, which must be properly tattooed, in two year and mature cow/calf classes. All animals must be legibly tattooed.
6. Market Heifers cannot be shown in purebred classes.

DEFINITIONS

1. All purebred registered animals, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually or jointly) are considered to be the production of the farm or breeding unit on which they are maintained.
2. In each classification where the same or common interest are involved in more than one breeding operation, such operations are considered as one breeding unit. In all cases where there is any doubt that more than one breeding unit exists, the interpretation should be that only one breeding unit exists. The responsibility of proof of separation of breeding units shall rest with the exhibitor(s).

IMPORTANT TO EXHIBITORS

1. Proof of liability insurance must accompany each entry form for the animals being shown. Entries will not be processed until this is received and are subject to late entry fees.
2. Entries close on Friday, September 9th at 4:00 p.m. Entries will not be taken over the phone.
3. The entry fee is 15% of the prize money awarded.
4. Late entry fee is an additional 5% of the prize money awarded.
5. NO CATTLE OR TIE-UP EQUIPMENT ON FAIRGROUNDS BEFORE THURSDAY AT 9:00 am.
6. Cattle must not be removed before 4:00 p.m. the day of the show – BUT must be out of the barn by 6:00 p.m.
7. Code of ethics for all dairy cattle exhibitors

The following supports good animal husbandry practices at shows, while presenting a positive image to spectators. All exhibitors and their fitters, agents, or other representatives agree to abide by the following rules and regulations.

PART 1

The following practices or procedures are unacceptable in the show ring or registered dairy cattle:

1. Misrepresenting the age or ownership of an animal
2. Filling an animal's rumen unnaturally with liquid (tubing)
3. Administering epidural anaesthesia (blocking tails) and/or applying any irritant either externally or internally to the perineal (rectum and vagina) area
4. Inserting foreign material/articles under the skin, into the topline (including hair not attached to its own hair follicle) or on the feet (administration of acceptable medications, and false switches and tails is permitted)
5. Performing surgery of any kind to change the natural contour of appearance of the animal's body, hide or hair. Not included is the removal of warts, teats and horns, clipping and dressing of hair and trimming of hooves
6. Criticizing or interfering with the judge, show management or other exhibitors, or other conduct detrimental to the breed or show
7. Wrapping hocks or draining fluid from hocks unless authorized by a veterinarian at the show

PART 2

All exhibitors and their fitters, agents or other representatives agree to abide by the following procedures:

1. Exhibitors, agents, employees or other person acting on behalf of an exhibitor, shall deliver to an inspector upon request any hypodermic syringe, needle or other device, swabs, cloths or other material, or samples or any medicine, preparation or substance, whether in liquid or other form, for the purposes of laboratory analysis.
2. All entries and personal property of the exhibitors, their servants and agents and persons acting on behalf of exhibitors, are subject to inspection by inspectors authorized by a show. All such persons shall co-operate with the inspectors and shall provide all such information in connection with such inspections and shall provide access to the animal and all information reasonably required by inspectors in connection with such inspections and shall provide, if so required, samples of urine, milk, blood or any other body fluids suitable for analysis.
3. Exhibitors shall remove any udder supports, blankets or other objects limiting the ability of the inspector to undertake a thorough inspection.
4. The Exhibitor agrees to act at all times in accordance with the Rules and Regulations for Showing and the Standard Procedures, and will accept any final decision made thereunder.

Violators are subject to the disciplinary provisions of the Standard Procedures and Penalties for Enforcing Rules and Regulations for Showing Dairy Cattle, and/or other show rules and regulations.

ATTENTION

To be eligible for prize money, each breed must be shown separately and have at least:

1. All exhibits must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor. All animals must be legibly tattooed if applicable. All exhibitors will be required to present registration certificates on demand by an official of the Show.

Failure to comply with this request will disqualify entries or animals from being exhibited.

2. All exhibits must be registered in the name of the exhibitor in accordance with the by-laws of the Association. The certificate of registration must state if the animal is purebred or at least 75% of purebred inheritance, registered and recorded on the records of the Association in the name of the exhibitor. No animals will be accepted without a registration certificate or facsimile copy of both sides of up-to-date registration certificate from the breed offices. There will be no exceptions and no animal will be allowed to show on a signed transfer or Photostat certificate of registry. Each animal will be checked for show eligibility against its registration certificate prior to showing.
3. The calculation of Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder points per exhibitor and per breeder will be assessed on a maximum of ten (10) animals shown and earning points in the individual classes.
