6. Knitted Matching set, any two of three, hat, scarf, and mitts (attach a sample of yarn)
7. Seasonal poem, handwritten in cursive, double spaced on unlined paper, mounted. Minimum 8 lines.
8. Reuse/Recycle project: Create a bag or purse from old jeans
9. Butter Tarts (without nuts or raisins) - 3
10. Quilted pillow maximum 18" square
11. Chocolate Chip Muffins (3)
12. Collection of 6-8 photos depicting "Children and Agriculture". Photos must be mounted on a piece of Bristol Board (11"x17")
13. A handmade Invitation (on card stock 4" x 6").
14. Decorative Wreath or Swag
15. Tea Cozy, sewn
16. 3 Pieces of Maple Fudge
17. Gift in a Jar (Layer your favourite homemade soup mix or cookie mix ingredients in a sealer jar, attach preparation instructions)
